Conditions of Offer

Application- Applications, which should be made through the school Principal, are invited from parents or guardians of year six children who may or may not be attending Matamata Christian School at the time of application. Applications must be made in writing stating why the recipient should be awarded the scholarship and include any supporting documents, such as referee statements, the applicant may consider helpful to their application. Applications must include a signed copy of the foundations Scholarship policy.

Criteria- Applicants will be assessed on the depth and maturity in, understanding of, and attitude towards all things Christian, their living out Proverbs 23:12 being eager to listen and eager to learn and the degree that they exhibit an encouraging spirit as the Apostle Barnabas did.

Financial benefits- Successful applicants will have 100% of their year seven and year eight Proprietor Fees (Attendance Dues) paid while the child is enrolled at the school. The Foundation may consider other costs that may be supported also.

Accountability- Successful applicants will be expected to actively live out Proverbs 23:12, being eager to listen and eager to learn, and to be “encouragers” in the school. Accountability will be under guidance from the teacher. It will take into consideration the age of the student, and include suitable self planning and self assessment, with up to twice yearly reporting to the Foundation.

Selection- Applications will be assessed by a committee consisting of an appointee from the Foundation, the Proprietor Board and the Principal. One or more recipients may be accepted each year, depending upon the number of suitable applicants and available funding.
